



Mississauga United FC Anti-Bullying and Anti-Discrimination Policy

Policy Statement:

Mississauga United FC is dedicated to fostering a culture of respect, inclusion, and fairness within our organization. We are committed to creating an environment free from all forms of discrimination and bullying, where every member feels valued and supported.

Scope:

This policy applies to all members, players, coaches, officials, volunteers, staff, and visitors associated with Mississauga United FC, including but not limited to athletes, parents, spectators, and sponsors.

Policy Guidelines:

- 4. Reporting Mechanism:** Members who experience or witness any form of discrimination or bullying are encouraged to report it promptly. A clear and confidential reporting mechanism will be provided.
- 5. Investigation and Resolution:** Reports of discrimination or bullying will be thoroughly investigated, and appropriate actions will be taken, including disciplinary measures if necessary.
- 6. Support and Prevention:** Mississauga United FC will provide support for victims and implement preventive measures to create a culture of respect, fairness, and inclusion.
